Juliette Wright is a passionate charitable giving advocate and the Founder and Director of not-for-profit donation platform GIVIT. Motivated to reduce the impacts of hardship in the community, Juliette set out to ensure quality goods reached the hands of people in need. In 2009, Juliette founded GIVIT to enable everyday Australians to see exactly what's required by vulnerable members of the community.

GIVIT has now facilitated the donation of more than eight million essential items to people in need. Working with over 4,500 support organisations around Australia, GIVIT ensures people recovering from an emergency event, or experiencing hardship due to domestic and family violence, homelessness, disability or mental illness get exactly what they need.

Juliette has been the recipient of several awards including Australia's Local Hero by the National Australia Day Council in 2015 and induction into the Australian Businesswomen's Network Hall of Fame. She received the Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) in 2019.

Juliette is committed to growing a network of givers to channel the generosity of everyday people to where it is needed most.

About GIVIT

GIVIT is a not-for-profit donation platform that works with more than 4,700 support organisations around Australia to ensure vulnerable people get what they need when they need it most. This includes people recovering from an emergency event, or experiencing hardship due to circumstances such as drought, domestic and family violence, homelessness, disability, and mental health. Through GIVIT.org.au, offers of goods and services are captured online, removing the need for charities and services to sort, store and dispose of unrequested donations, saving valuable resources. 100% of donated money received by GIVIT to support people in need are used to purchase essential items and services.
